These 511NY Open Source Principles, together with the Developer Access Agreement, govern your access to and use of the data in the 511NY Developer Resources Area. By continuing to access and use the data you are deemed to have fully understood the Developer Access Agreement and the 511NY Open Source Principles.

Troubleshooting

511NY and NYSDOT have very limited resources. Respect the resources of NYSDOT, NYSDOT's partner agencies and vendors who make data available to the developer community.

Respect the Source

Developers should limit use "511NY" or any combination of (511NY logo or logos) and NYSDOT's Partner (logo, state seal, etc.) to the reasonable conditions stated in the Developer Access Agreement. Please acknowledge the source of the provided data.

Maintain Condition

Availability of this data is a new initiative and reasonable efforts will be made by NYSDOT to warn users in a timely fashion of both expected and unexpected changes in the operational status of the 511NY system and its contributors.

Open Source

We want to foster innovative new applications and reach out to a broader audience. When possible, use open standards, formats, and software. Be willing to share your innovative apps.

Legal

Building applications does not increase the likelihood you will be awarded a contract by NYSDOT now or in the future.

Communication

This intent of this project is to foster innovative new applications which improve access to travel info that leads to a more reliable, safe, and efficient transportation network. Let's keep communication open at all times. Think of ways for improving our community and share those ideas.
